THIS DEED OF TRUST (WITNESSED) AND DECLARED AS FOLLOWS:

1. NAME:

The name of the trust shall be "SRI KRISHNA EDUCATIONAL TRUST" The office of the trust shall be situated for the present at No.74, West Street, Mazhaiyampattu post, Thiruvennainallur(Via), Tirkoilur Taluk, Villupuram District, Tamil Nadu or such the place or place as the trustees may decide from time to time.

2. BENEFICIARIES:

The benefits to the trust are open to all public irrespective of caste, religion, sex etc.,

3. OBJECTS:

The objects of the trust are:

A) To spread knowledge and education by the publication of books, classics and other literature and /or by establishment of specific endowment and memorials for public charitable purposes.

- C) To held promote education and learning primary, higher and college education, non -technical, agricultural, engineering, medical, commercial, financial, management, scientific philosophic or any subject relating to arts, culture if any other subject of education and research work in all subjects, and to establish run, maintain of finance by adhoc or annual grants or otherwise schools, colleges and /or other institutions for (a) or any of the aforesaid purposes.
- D) To Establish professorships, lectureship and to give scholarships and prizes or any other similar help or encouragement of the advancement of education.
- E) To make pecuniary grants by giving scholarships, education fee, fellowships, stipends or otherwise to (deserving) or deserving or meritorious poor students for their students, research and training, education, etc., In any branch including (or free) (12) & confessional supply of their food, clothing, residence, books, etc.,
- F) To provide free medical relief by actual payment of expenses for medical treatment of poor or deserving persons.
- G) To establish, construct, maintain finance by adhoc assistance or otherwise, hospitals, nursing homes, medical colleges, wards and institutions for the relief of the sick and to aid and cooperate with other institutions and societies doing similar work.
- H) To provide for relief of the poor and in particular to help incapacitated persons in poor and destitute circumstances by giving doles in money or in kind, free food and the like, irrespective of their caste, creed of colour.
- I) To take steps to disseminate scientific, technical and cultural knowledge and to raise the standard of life and health among the backward sections of the people. (22)

- J) To conduct lectures, seminars, symposiums and conferences on all subjects and to award scholarships, Prizes or trophies for the advancement of the above subjects.
- K) To conduct or donate to any benevolent or charitable purpose and to establish funds therefor.
- L) To construct new ^{(24) (25)} wells and maintain and repair existing wells, tanks and other resources or water for the public and to give monetary help for the same.
- M) To establish or help in establishing institutions of the treatment and shelter for animals.
- N) To give monetary aids or other help for relief from natural calamities like floods, cyclone, tempest or otherwise, to give monetary aid or other help for the disposal of deceased persons or cremation or performance of obsequies.

3. TRUST FUND

The author of the trust declares that the sum of Rs. 1001/- (Rupees one thousand and ⁽³⁴⁾ one only) that has been dedicated by his for public charitable purposes and objects of general Public utility described above the receipt of which the trustees have acknowledged and that the trustees shall and will stand Possessed of said sum of Rs. 1001/- (Rupees one thousand and one only) upon trust and also any other ⁽³⁵⁾ Properties, movable or immovable, which the trustees may ⁽³⁶⁾ ~~from~~ ⁽³⁷⁾ ~~time to time~~ ⁽³⁸⁾ receive for augmenting the trust fund or for specified purposes connected with the objects of the trust not calculated to impede the due working of the trust arising from a nations, bequests, gifts, legacies or grants in cash ⁽³⁹⁾ ~~working~~ ⁽⁴⁰⁾ or from any other source whatsoever and also of any investments for the time being representing the said (Here in after called the trust fund) and also of the net income from the trust fund into the trust, and to apply both the income and capital of the trust for the purpose of the trust. The trust fund shall be held in the name of the trust and not in the same or names of the trustees.

If the objects for which this trust has been created shall fail, or cannot be satisfactorily fulfilled for any reason, the board of trustees shall be at liberty to apply the trust fund or any portion thereof to any other trust or institution having objects wholly or in part similar to this trust.

Investment of funds shall be in accordance with provision of section 13(1) (d) read with section 11(5) of the income tax act. ⁽⁴¹⁾

Any amendment to the trust deed shall be carried out only with approval of the commissioner of the income tax. ⁽⁴²⁾

- h) Surplus funds of the trust shall be invested in the manner specified under the income – tax act and any modifications to be made thereunder from time to time. ⁽⁵⁰⁾
- i) To incur all such expenses as are necessary for the execution of the trust and powers under these presents.
- j) To raise donations or accept gifts of contributions in cash or any kind.
- k) ^(a) To appoint auditors to audit the accounts of trust. ^{(77a) (1) a}
- l) to appoint legal advisers for the trust.
- m) To appoint such staff as may be necessary for the administration of the trust on such remuneration, commission or salary as ^{(77a) (1) a} trustees may think proper and suspend, remove or replace them whenever necessary. ^{(52) (54)}
- n) To re-emburse the trustees towards the pocket expenses which ^{(52) (54)} may be incurred by them in the course of or in relation to the affairs of the trust.
- o) To receive donations, contributions, gifts, bequests, legacies and endowments from individuals, charitable or other trust or institution for the objects of the trust on such terms and conditions as may be accepted by the trustees.
- p) To make, alter, restriction any rules or regulations in regard to the conduct of affairs in respect of which any power or duty is vested in them for the convenient and effective management and administration of the trust. ⁽⁵⁵⁾

6.2 CHAIRMAN :-

The chairman is empowered to supervise generally all activities of the trust. The board of trustees meeting shall be presided by the chairman. The chairman shall perform all the activities of the trust perfectly for the improvement of the same along with secretary. The chairman shall conduct all legal cases that arise if any out of the (activities) of the trust.

6.3 SECRETARY :-

The secretary is responsible to administer the trust. The secretary shall be subordinate to the executive committee. It is the duty of the secretary to (convene) meeting, to maintain properly all the records of the trust and look over (properly) all the activities of the trust. He shall act on consultation with the chairman.

7 (b) - POWER TO CO-OPT :-

The trustees shall have the power to co-opt additional trust or to fill up any existing vacancy in the board of trustees, so however that the total number of trustees shall not be (below) or exceed the number fixed in clause 5(b) supra

8 VACACIES OCCURING IN THE OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES :-

The vacancies (occurring) in the office of the trustees shall be filed by the remaining trustees within 3 months of the arising of such vacancies. If there are not trustees, functioning at any point of time, the trustees shall be appointed in according with the law by a court of competent jurisdiction. Where at any time the number of trustees fall below minimum prescribed in clause 5(b) supra the continuing trustees shall have the power co-opt any person or persons to fill up such vacancy.

9 VACANCY NOT TO INVALIDATE THE PROCEEDING :-
Any vacancy in the board of trustees and / or any illegality in appointment of (Trustees) of their proceedings shall not invalidated any prior act decision of the Board of trustees. (22)

10 ADMINISTRATOR

The board of trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the trust, its properties and affairs the performance for which the trust is established. The Board of trustees shall act though the managing trustee.

11 APPOINTMENT OF MANAGING TRUSTEES :-

The first managing trustee shall be shri. R. Vivekanandhan hold the office for a period of 5 years. Thereafter a managing trustee shall be selected from among the Board of trustees to hold office for a period not exceeding 3 years. The managing trustee shall have all the power vested in the board of trustees and shall act on behalf of the board of trustees subject to all control and Superintendence of the board of trustees.

12 PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEES

The board of trustees may as often as may be necessary for the efficient conduct of the trust. The trustees may make decisions on any matter either at their meetings or by circulation of resolutions on paper. If any of the trustees are absent in 3 consecutive board meeting without a prior leaving of absence sanctioned by the board shall be deemed to have vacated his office. (22)

13. QUORUM :-

The minimum number of trustees to be present for conducting a meeting of the board of trustees shall be two.

14. VOTING :-

Each trustees shall have one vote. The opinion of the ⁽⁸¹⁾majority of the board of trustees present at a meeting shall be final in respect of all matters relating to the trust.

15. MINUTES ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT :-

The trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of the trust and a correct record of their deliberation and get the accounts duly audited by a chartered accountant.

16. NET INCOME OF THE TRUST :-

The trustees shall invest and recover the income of the trust fund and shall provide for all costs, charges incidental expenses including insurance premium expenses of ordinary repairs etc., And all other out goings and expenses for the management and administration of the trust.

17. CREATION OF RESERVES :-

The trustees shall set ⁽⁸²⁾apart ⁽⁸³⁾and credit to the depreciation sinking or other fund such percentage of or portion or whole of the income of the trust fund as may from time to time be determined by the trustees however as and when the balance standing to the credit of such funds exceeds the minimum amount which the trustees may from the trustees to transfer such surplus amount ⁽⁸⁴⁾to the general trust fund and apply it in the same manner as the net income or the trust fund. ⁽⁸⁵⁾

18. APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND :-

The trustees shall after providing for aforesaid payments and disbursements and other after setting apart any sum for sinking fund reserves etc., Apply and utilize the net income of the corpus of the trust, or the trust fund for fulfillment of all or (any of) the public charitable purposes of objects of general public utility referred in para 2 supra by such ways and means as the trustees may effort from time to time in their absolute and unfettered discretion determine.

Not with standing the power vested with the trustees under the proceeding clauses, no part of income of the trust shall ensure directly or indirectly and no part of the income or property of the trust shall be used or applied directly or indirectly, for the benefit if the trustees or any person who makes a substantial contribution to the trust or any relative of the trustees or the person who makes a substantial contribution.

The trustees shall not be entitled to draw any remuneration from the trust.

21. LIABILITY OF TRUSTEE OR TRUSTEES :-

In the professed execution of the trust and powers, conferred no trustees shall be liable for any loss to the trust properties arising by reason of improper investment made in good faith or for the negligence of fraud of any agent or employed of such agent shall not strictly be necessary (or expedient or by reason or any mistake or omission made in good faith by the trustees) or by (reason) of any other matter or thing except willful or deliberate fraud on the part of the trustees, who alone may be subject to be made so liable. In the event of dissolution of trust, the board of trustees shall be liberty to apply the trust fund or any position there of to any other trust or institution having objects wholly or in part similar to this trust.
